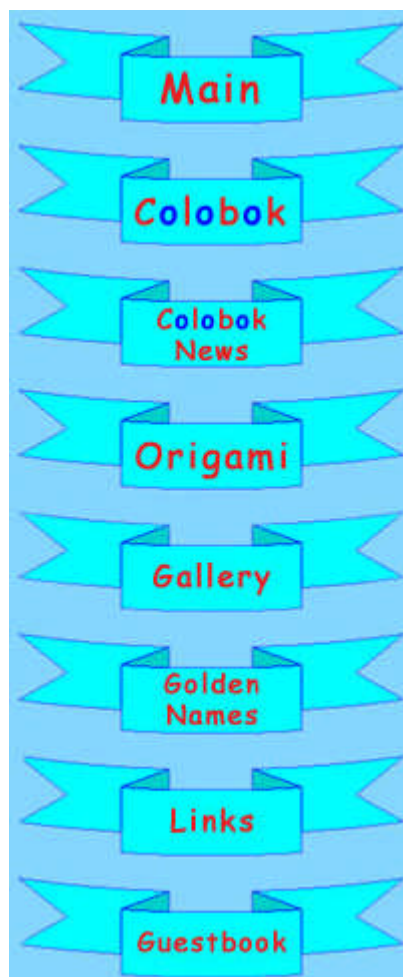




Wow!

Goal

To help young people to get a chance in their life to become a fully fledged citizen of the modern world through art and peace education.

Children express this amazing world through their creativity and imagination with Origami, the beautiful art of paper folding, and showing their artworks to their friends around the world.

Objective

To promote friendship and understanding among all children of different countries through the art of Origami.

Methods

To create vital scenes from past to future with groups of children in Origami technique that are showing the children's visions of the world as well the diversity and magnificence of our life on Earth as a place full of love and peace.

Eligibility

All students (between the ages of 5 and 16) without any limit may submit their artwork for the "WOW! WAW!" project site's virtual gallery. We invite children, who have no possibility to visit any art festival and cannot afford to send their artworks there by mail, to join the project. Group artworks are preferred.

Subjects

The central theme is human and nature life on our Planet in the present and in the past.

The Gallery

Pictures of the selected artwork will be displayed every month on the project site with the names of the students and organizations.

Submission Instructions

1. Artwork for the gallery can be submitted at any time.
2. The artwork of the month will be chosen by a jury out of all submissions.
3. All submissions also have the chance to be chosen as artwork of the year for the "WOW! WAW!" Award.
4. Each group of students may submit one entry a month with three pictures of the same scene made from different views and a picture of the students with their names if possible and the teacher and organization names as well with their contact mail and email addresses or web site.
5. These international artworks are part of a virtual exhibition that children from all over the world can enjoy at any time.

6. All submissions become property of the IAP "Peace Tree".
7. It is assumed that the artists understand these conditions. Submission of artwork implies acceptance of these terms.
8. The pictures may be used in exhibitions, for promotional material and for non-profit activities.
9. Please write in English - name of the country, city, your organization or group, names of the folders and the leader or a teacher (if possible), your contact mail and email address.
10. Please provide the pictures in the best quality you have available, if possible in printable quality.
